Project title: MILES IN MY SHOES

Project: The rising number of people entering Europe in search of safety and in search of a better life has captured the world's attention with scenes of heartbreaking tragedy. Travelling hundreds and thousands of miles over land and over water, from Africa, the Middle East and Asia, people are risking everything in the hope of reaching their goal, and the danger does not end at a border crossing.

The main aim of the project is to increase the quality of youth work services for migrants and refugees by equipping youth workers (coordinators, facilitators, mentors) with competencies in facilitating experiential learning.

The project is based on an intensive experiential learning process to reach following objectives:

- to enable participants to go through an experiential learning process and reflect on its different steps;
- to gain understanding on how to turn experience into learning and how to make it relevant for the needs of young migrants and refugees;
- to provide participants with educational tools and methodologies that will enable them to act as multipliers on refugee related issues in their work with young people;
- to enable participants to make informed decisions regarding their work on refugee related issues;
- to explore the dimensions of diversity in refugee related issues.
- to increase the knowledge of the background to experiential learning (theory, concepts, steps, philosophy);
- to increase the practical facilitation skills in experiential learning cycle (in various settings-beyond workshop context);
- to develop practical skills in designing and implementing experiential learning activities;
- to recognise the link between practical experiences and competencies gained for improving integration of migrants and refugees.

Training course venue: Limassol, Cyprus

Target group: Public organisation, Non-governmental organisations, youth groups, organisations that works with refugees, migrants, etc.

Participants: 2-3 active youth workers from each partner (no age limit).

Important details: The project will be financed by Erasmus+ programme. Therefore, food, accommodation, trips, activities will be fully covered, and according to the flat rate travel costs will be supplied. There is no





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participation fee. Organisations from all 27 EU member countries plus Liechtenstein, Macedonia, Norway and Iceland are eligible to take part.

Working language: English (therefore all participants need to have at least B2 level)
