- ▶ to promote a more flexible attitude towards cultural diversity in society,
- ▶ to promote a new form of intercultural dialogue and gender education in broader European context,
- ▶ to foster cooperation and socializing among young people, including those with fewer opportunities
- ▶ to promote Erasmus+ program as a possibility to promote gender equality and human rights issues among young people Europe wide.
